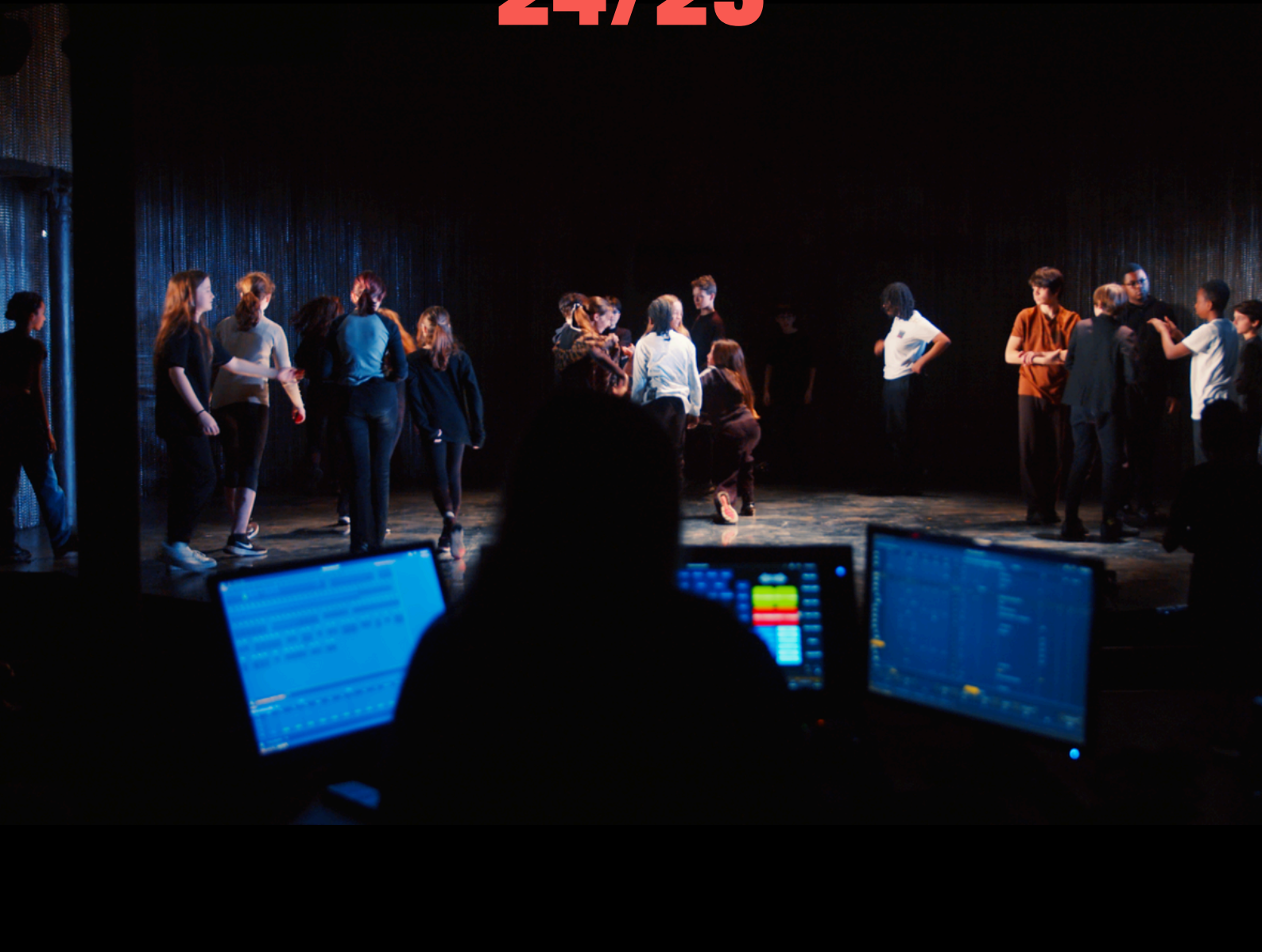


# ALMEIDA THEATRE SCHOOLS OFFER 24/25

# **SECONDARY + A LEVEL**

## **WHY DRAMA? WORKSHOPS YEARS 7 - 9**

Practical, high energy in-school sessions, aimed at inspiring students to pick Drama GCSE. Sessions are a taste of Almeida Unlocked and Young Company projects, signposting students to future opportunities to engage with us.

## **ALMEIDA UNLOCKED YEARS 7 - 13**

Ensemble-based devising project in response to an Almeida Production. Led by an Almeida artist in-school, students and teachers build a toolkit of techniques and develop a rapid response piece, culminating in a performance on the Almeida stage.

## **YOUNG COMPANY IN SCHOOLS YEARS 10 - 13**

After-school drama hubs culminating in a performance on the Almeida stage. Led by an Almeida artist, sessions are for students looking for advanced training, exploring devising and scene study with future opportunities to perform on the Almeida stage.

Islington schools are offered free tickets to every Almeida production. Our Schools Producer will contact teachers with a booking link, which will feature age guidance, content trigger warnings and technical warnings.

## **THEATRE TICKETS YEARS 7 - 13**

Bespoke workshops led by Almeida artists and industry professionals. Workshops are tailored for each Almeida production, to enhance students understanding of the play and the creative careers that surround a theatrical production.

## PRIMARY

### PRIMARY HUBS YEARS 3 - 6

After school drama clubs taking place weekly in primary schools across Islington.

An Almeida artist leads students through a series of storytelling drama games, aimed at exploring creativity, building confidence through collaborative performing and sparking an interest in the arts.

### HOLIDAY CLUBS YEARS 3 - 6

Packed with drama games and devising techniques, Almeida Holiday Clubs are designed to expand on the creative work explored in Primary Hubs through 4 days of collaborative working, developing performance skills and confidence through drama.

## TEACHERS

Led by industry professionals, masterclass are exclusively designed for teachers to continue professional development, building relationships with other local teachers whilst developing a toolkit of skills to apply to work in the classroom.

### MASTER CLASSESES

In addition to being offered free tickets for their school groups, all teachers are offered free tickets to a preview of each production as an opportunity to see the production before bringing their students.

### INSIGHT EVENINGS

Learning Resources are developed alongside each Almeida production, offering insights into the Almeida rehearsal room and creative decisions made by the Director. Digital resources include interviews with cast and creatives.
